Followed up with a selection of effective designs.

February 21, 2024 Joint Dinner Meeting

The fourth meeting of the ASHE Mid-Allegheny Section 2023-2024 program together with the ASHE Altoona section was presented at the University of Pittsburgh at Johnstown (UPJ) Living-Learning Center-Heritage Hall in Johnstown, PA. Opening remarks were presented by ASHE Altoona Section President, **Matthew Walerysiak**, **PE**, and ASHE Mid-Allegheny Section President, **Sean Hart, PE.** The presentation of the evening focused on the 6th, 7th, and 9th Street Bridges Rehabilitation Project in Pittsburgh presented by **Aaron Colorito**, **PE** of Michael Baker International, Inc.

The project included rehabilitating the same bridge three times allowing for economies of scale in the design. Lessons learned were carried forward to the other structures. Aaron discussed the repairs performed on the bridges and issues encountered during construction. Majority of work was structural steel repairs & painting. Other repairs performed were: strengthening the deteriorated steel, strengthening the stringer copes, new steel curbs, repairing/replacing sidewalks, new tie-downs, new shear connectors, new deck, eye bars, pin nuts, masonry cleaning, and enhanced lighting systems.

After Aaron's presentation, the UPJ students presented on the ASCE Pitt-Johnstown Activities which consisted of: the Steel Bridge Competition, the Concrete Canoe Competition, the Estimating Competition, the UESI Surveying Competition, and Associated General Contractors of America field trips and events. It was great to hear and learn about the events and competitions that the students are participating in at UPJ.

March 13, 2024 Dinner Meeting

The ASHE Mid-Allegheny Section held the fifth dinner meeting of the 2023-2024 program at the Indiana Country Club. Opening remarks were presented by ASHE Mid-Allegheny Section President, **Sean Hart, PE.** The presentation by GPI on SR 92 Stone Masonry Arch Rehabilitation took us through the evening.

Chris Messner, PE and Bob Bochicchio, PE presented on the rehabilitation of the stone masonry arch that had split ownership between the state and the railroad and abutted against the Susquehanna River. The existing stone and timber supports had structural deficiencies that needed repair while maintaining the historic qualities of the structure. Due to extensive detour lengths single lane of traffic was maintained under temporary widening. A soil nail wall and concrete foundation were used to support the existing roadway. Storing and reusing the existing stone was a complex operation that went successfully.

The section appreciated Chris and Bob taking the time and traveling to present this project to the section.
